How Do You Apply?

All you need to do is submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you are eligible, you will receive the NC Need-Based Scholarship. There are no additional forms to fill out.

The amount of your scholarship depends on your federal Student Aid Index (SAI) that you can find on your FAFSA Submission Summary after submitting the FAFSA. **Even if you do not qualify for a federal Pell Grant, you may still qualify for an NC Need-Based Scholarship.**

Full Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a North Carolina resident for tuition purposes, including certain veterans and active-duty military members and their dependents.
- Be enrolled as an undergraduate student in at least 6 credit hours/semester at a qualifying private North Carolina campus.
- Be enrolled in an eligible degree or certificate program.
- Not have a previous bachelor's degree.
- Demonstrate financial need based on the Student Aid Index (SAI) from the FAFSA.
- Be a US citizen or eligible non-citizen.
