How to Use: One-Pager

- The following NC College Connect one-pager has been developed to provide another way to amplify NC College Connect with students at your school or college and in your communities.
- This one-pager is sized to print on 8.5x11" paper. Print this to share at events and with those in your network. It is not designed for sharing on social media and should not be used in that medium.

YOUR MOMENT HAS ARRIVED, AND THIS IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO MEET IT HEAD ON. With NC College Connect, you can be directly admitted to participating colleges and universities where you already admissions requirements. No essays, test scores, or recommendation letters needed. Yes, it's that easy.

Seniors—if you had a 2.8 weighted GPA at the end of your junior year and meet NC College Connect requirements, you're already in! Not a senior just yet? You could be eligible for this program next year!

NC College Connect is a program that directly admits North Carolina public high school seniors to participating UNC System universities, North Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities, and their local North Carolina community college where they already meet admissions requirements.

If you've been admitted to college through NC College Connect, here's what you need to know:

1. To see what institutions you've been admitted to and accept your admission, scan the QR code on your letter (or the one below!) to visit [NCCollegeConnect.org](#).
2. There you will find a "Claim My Spot" button that will take you to the NC College Connect portal if you are already logged into your CFNC account.
3. After logging in or creating a CFNC account, you will see a list of colleges and universities where you've been admitted. You'll just need to complete a short form to accept your admission at the institutions of your choice. You'll see formal acceptance letters in your portal as well.
4. For your local community college, the program will redirect to that institution's traditional application—but don't worry, you already meet application requirements and are already admitted! The application is quick and easy.
5. You only need to apply once—through NC College Connect—to reach participating institutions, with no need to complete separate applications through their traditional processes.

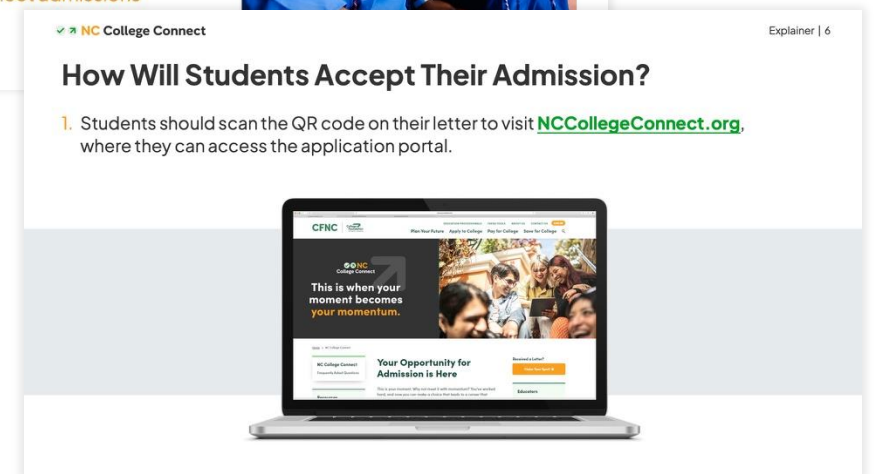
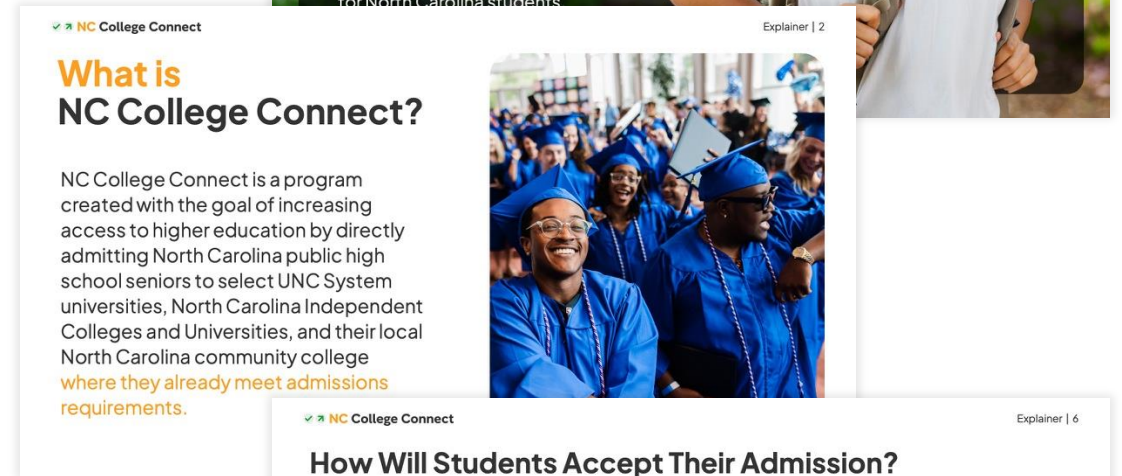
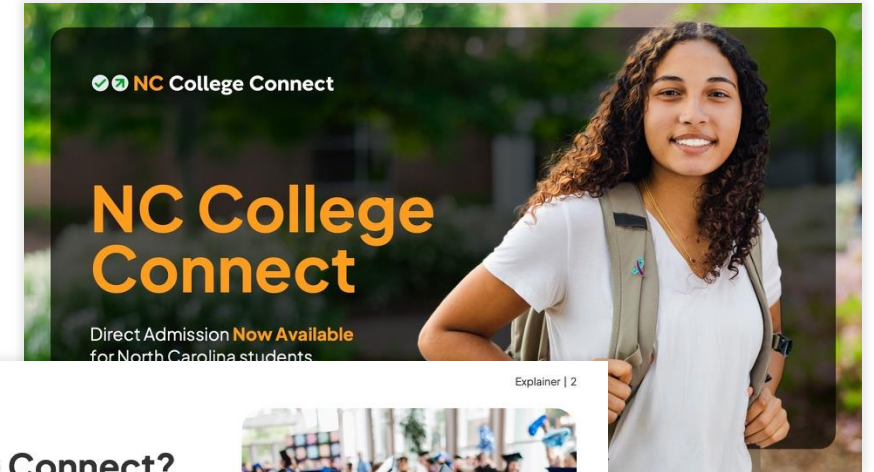

*Note – this was written with all students in mind, not just those eligible for NC College Connect.
